



**1.:**

**MAINTENANCE**

Monitor/measure disease pressure  
 maintain Spraying schedule  
 Keep irrigating normally. Stop irrigation 10 days before haulm killing

**2.:**

**HAULM KILLING**

Take of the leaves/canopy preferable by haulm **PULLING.**

**3.:**

**MATURING**

Leave the potatoes sufficient time in the field after haulm killing. This to allow the potato skin to set / mature / harden.

**4.:**

**HARVESTING**

Digging / Picking / Sorting directly in the field.  
 Place the tubers on jute bags for drying  
 Take out damaged and rotten tubers!

**5.:**

**HANDLING**

Take good care of the potatoes  
 Avoid dropping heights!  
 Take out damaged and rotten tubers!

**6.:**

**BAGGING**

Potatoes to be packed in 50 kg net bags  
 Handle potatoes with care!  
 Handle bags with care!  
 Avoid dropping heights!

**7.:**

**LABELS / MARKS**

All bags should be labelled correctly  
 Field code must be attached to each bag  
 Good quality labels should be used

**8.:**

**LOGISTICS**

Take care when loading the potatoes.  
 Avoid dropping heights!  
 Take care during transport.

**9.:**

**WEIGHING**

All bags should be weighed separately  
 Take care of an accurate administration  
 Handle bags with care!  
 Avoid dropping heights!

**10.:**

**COLD STORE**

Cluster the bags from each field.  
 Handle bags with care!  
 Avoid dropping heights!
